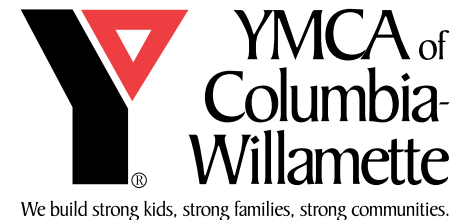

The YMCA is a drug free work place.

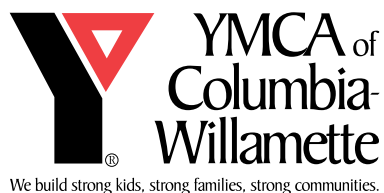


OUR CULTURE
